Sunday 1st June, 10:30am: Special service at Hathersage Methodist Church as the Peace Pilgrimage comes to the Hope Valley (29 May-2 June). Christian CND (Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament) is a group of activists from across the UK who work and pray for a world free of nuclear weapons. At the end of May they are holding a 'peace pilgrimage' travelling through Sheffield and the Hope Valley. The aim of the pilgrimage is to raise awareness, spend time in prayer and reflection, and meet with local peace groups.
